- Training is led by professional coaches who have regularly competed at the highest level

- Facilities include golf short course training centre, 50 and 25 metre pools, 6 tennis courts, fully equipped fitness centre and sports hall, 3 full size football pitches (12x7 aside)

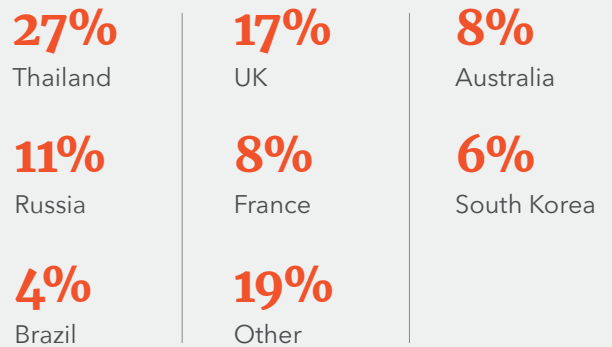

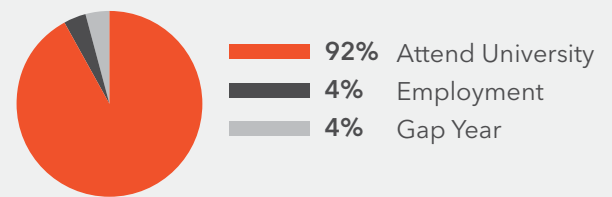

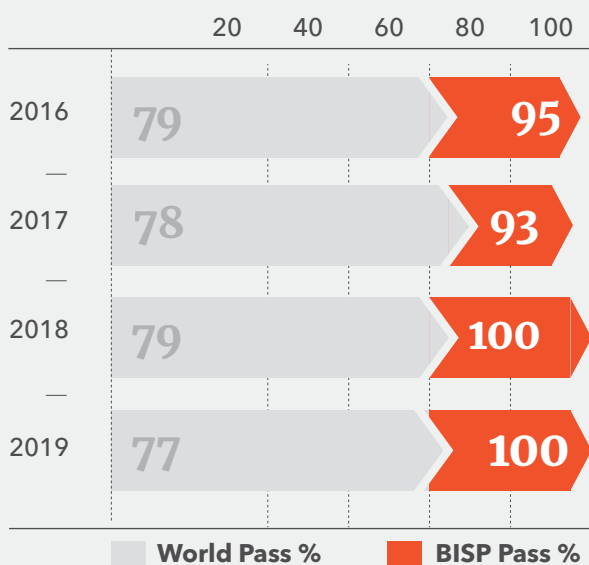
Classes of 2016–2019



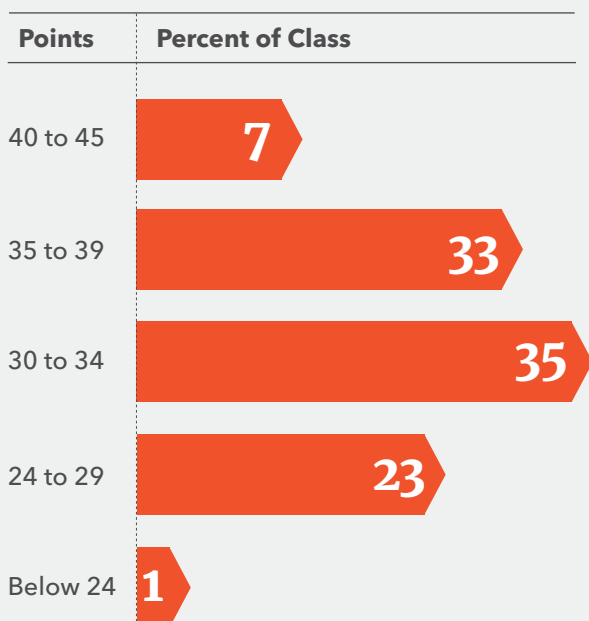
University Applications

- Official transcripts are only sent from BISP directly to universities, they are not given to students

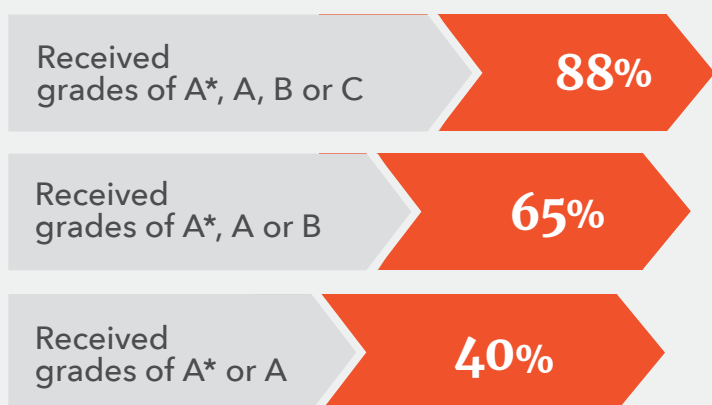
IB Diploma Pass Rate

IGCSE Grades 2016-2019



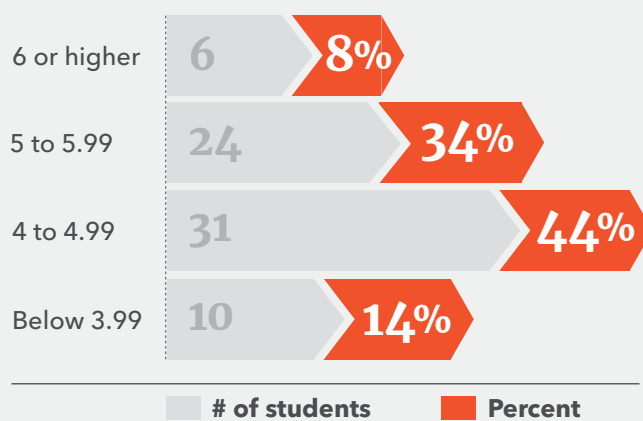
