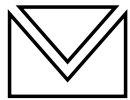


How do we **communicate** with parents **at BISP?**

Essential Information



Email

Email is the primary channel of communication for essential information to parents. You can expect to receive all invoices, fee information, term dates and any private information regarding your child via email. This information is deemed essential.



Seesaw & Tapestry

In Early Years and Primary, we use online learning journal Apps, Seesaw and Tapestry. On these platforms, you can see what your child has been learning in class, read important updates from classroom teachers (Seesaw only) and also message teachers directly (Seesaw only). Once you have downloaded these Apps to your mobile device or tablet, you will receive instructions from your child's classroom teacher on how to create a password and log in to access your child's learning journal. When content is posted, you will receive a red notification symbol on the App, as well as an email to inform you that new content has been added.



Google Classroom

We use Google Classroom in the Secondary School. This is primarily a learning platform connecting teachers and students, but you may also opt-in to receive emails sent from Google Classroom, listing your child's due and completed work.



Parent Portal

The Parent Portal icon is located in the top right corner of our website and is password protected. Depending on what section of the school your child is in, you may view your child's timetable, upcoming assessments, and mid and end-of-year reports.



CHQ

CHQ is the online management system we use which allows you to select, view and manage your child's extra-curricular activities. When you join BISP you will receive an automated email from our Extended Curriculum Coordinator with your CHQ parent login details.



Emergency Comms

Parents receive phone calls if their child is absent without prior notification, ill and needing medical treatment, or in any other emergency situation. In the event of a school emergency, like a fire, campus lockdown or closure, parents will be alerted via SMS and updates will continue via mobile phone unless there is a disruption to the mobile network. Direct email and website pop-up notifications are also used in emergency situations.



Parent Conferences

Due to recent events, parents may now choose between a video conference with their child's teacher or an in-person conference (if circumstances allow) when conference requests are made.

We host a number of workshops for parents throughout the year and often enlist the help of both in-house and external consultants to deliver them. Topics covered in the past include areas such as Parenting in the Digital Age and Supporting Children in Sport, along with regular workshops focused on GCSE and IB subject selection and choosing the right university for your child.
