Our Expectations

A successful volunteer will possess the following qualities. He or she:

- Will be outgoing and friendly;
- Should enjoy working with young people;
- Will maintain the highest professional standards on a par with the teaching staff;
- Will have some experience in: Sports Swimming Football -Tennis - Golf - Triathlon - Basketball; Arts - Musicals - Instrumental lessons - Dance - Drama; working with children of any age;
- Will have some experience working with young people in a residential capacity.

Aims/Duties

- Providing support related to subject specification
- Assisting Boarding House Parents with the weekend and evening activity program
- Assisting with after school activities
- Getting involved in the wider community and cultural life of the school
- Assisting with residential and educational visits outside of Phuket
- Initiating team building, team games and sporting competitions for boarders
- Develop a professional understanding of teaching or coaching as a vocation

BISP is located on the beautiful island of Phuket, approximately 860 km south of the capital, Bangkok. It is a comprehensive day and boarding school, providing quality education for pupils aged from 2 years to 18 years. Gap intern assistants have contributed to the success of BISP from our earliest days and their role continues to be an integral part of daily academic and boarding life.

Benefits

- Volunteers are housed in individual rooms in one of our Boarding houses free of charge;
- Rooms are fitted with beds, bedding, wardrobes, mirror and air-conditioning;
- Communal area with TV;
- Three meals a day during school term time;
- Free laundry during school time;
- Volunteers paid approximately 10000 baht per month;
- Volunteers are offered free group transportation with a school driver and minibus to a destination on the island, once a week, subject to availability;
- Health and accident insurance while in Thailand (Holiday trips will require personal insurance);
- References provided upon completion of service;
- Holidays include one week in October; three weeks around Christmas time; one week in February and two weeks in April. Volunteers can travel during these times in the Asia region;
- Volunteers are paid from August to June

Opportunities - In service opportunities including:

- Classroom teaching experience;
- Professional development with teaching staff

Airfare and Visa

• Airfare, visa and re-entry permits are the responsibility of the volunteer (The school will provide the necessary documentation for a Non-Immigrant visa)

We require volunteers to start in August each year.
