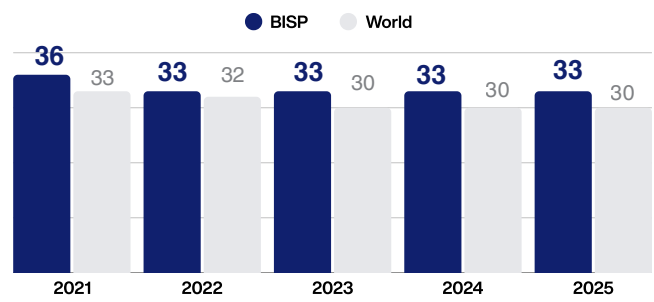

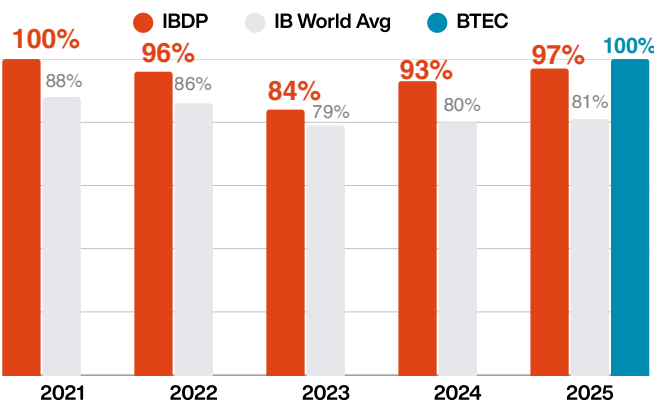

BISP IB Average

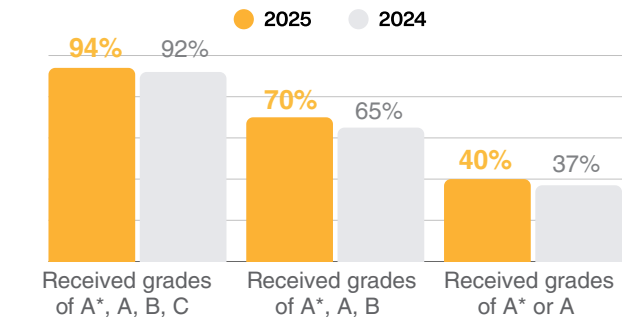


BISP IB Diploma and BTEC Pass Rate

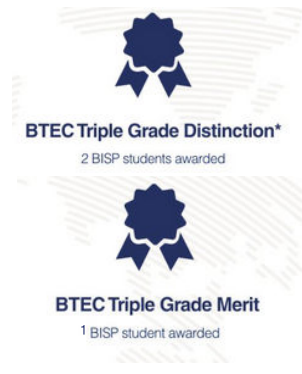

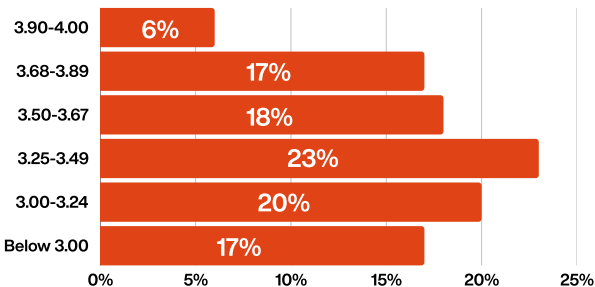

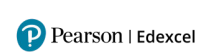
