HOW DO WE STUDY?

A focus on skills based learning, the course is designed around mandatory and optional units where evidence is presented based on actual work and studies. Students can demonstrate their skills and knowledge while building a portfolio of work.

The BTEC course allows students to show what you have learnt in each unit and build on achievements as you progress.

WHAT IS IT?

The BTEC International Level 3 in Business is a practical, career-focused qualification shaped by global industry experts. Combining real-world projects with academic study, it develops key skills in management, marketing, finance, and entrepreneurship, preparing students for university or employment.

- A two-year, full-time course (1080 GLH).

WHAT MAKES A SUCCESSFUL STUDENT OF BUSINESS?

To study Business, you must have a genuine interest in learning about aspects of the world of work. You must show commitment and a genuine interest in keeping up-to-date with business in a broad sense. You must be organised and able to keep to deadlines for all work, especially your assignments.

Perhaps most importantly, you must be independent, so you must be able to demonstrate that you are resourceful in order to complete tasks, whether that is by researching specific topics, referring back to your own notes in order to complete tasks, or seeking advice if you are unsure. It is desirable for students wishing to take BTEC Business, to have achieved a C or above in IGCSE Business Studies.

WHAT OUR BUSINESS STUDIES FACULTY SAYS

We believe that this course offers students a unique chance to experience what business feels like in the real world. Through projects such as marketing campaigns, business pitches, financial analysis, and work experience, our students don't just study business, they live it.

WHAT DOES THE STUDY OF BUSINESS INVOLVE?

BTEC Business is a practical, career-focused qualification that helps students understand how businesses work and how to apply that knowledge in real situations. Instead of being mainly exam-based like traditional A-levels and the IB Diploma, it combines coursework, practical projects, and some external assessments, making it hands-on and skills-oriented.

In short, the BTEC Business course is about understanding business theory AND applying it practically to real-world situations.



WHO ARE THESE QUALIFICATIONS FOR?

The Pearson BTEC International Level 3 qualifications in Business, and in Enterprise and Entrepreneurship, are primarily designed for learners in the 16–19 age group, who wish to pursue a career in business, primarily via higher education to access graduate entry employment with businesses, or alternatively through junior business employment.

HOW ARE BTEC'S ASSESSED?



Assessed using assignments and projects.



Work-related, real-life scenarios build knowledge and skills over time.



Deliver a project using a combination of knowledge, skills and behaviours.





Assignments produced and marked by teachers.



Students will get a grade for each unit, Pass, Merit or Distinction.



At the end of the qualification, students get a final grade based on unit grade achievement.
